## Sees New Anti-Israel Plot in State Dept.

Daniel Frisch, recently-elected president of the Zionist Organization of America, charged yesterday that pro-Arab officials in the State Dept. were "plotting anew against the State of Israel." He urged President Truman :o intervene.

Speaking at a press conference at the American Zionist Emergency Council, 342 Madison Ave., Frisch stated that "all indications point to a new campaign by unfriendly officials of the State Department inspired by the irreconcilable attitude of the British Foreign Office in a concerted attempt upon the territorial integrity of the new state."
He declined to identify the

officials.
