Nehru Suggests A Plebiscite by U.N. in Kashmir Asserts India is Willing to Have Referendum Once Peace Has Been Attained

NEW DELHI, Nov. 2 (AP)—Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru said tonight the Dominion of India is prepared to have a referendum conducted in Kashmir "under international auspices like the United Nations," once peace is restored in that princely state.

Mr. Nehru, whose government would enable residents of Kashmir to decide whether they wished their state to be permanently attached to India or to the Moslem Dominion of Pakistan.
