

Jewish Immigrant Ship Leaves Romania Empty

ISTANBUL, Dec. 23 (UP).—Diplomatic sources said today that the American ship Pan Crescent, flying the flag of Panama, left Constanta empty yesterday, two months after it entered that Romanian port to pick up Jewish illegal immigrants to Palestine. A sister ship, the Pan York, also empty, was expected to leave today.

Local sources believed the trips were canceled because the United Nations decision to partition Palestine will soon open the door to increased legal immigration.

French Hold Italian Crew

TOULON, France, Dec. 23 (UP).—Police today held the skipper and twelve crew members of a 300-ton Italian ship suspected of entering French water to take on a load of Jewish immigrants to Palestine. The ship, the Scetti Fratelli, was towed to Toulon Saturday and impounded.
