

Jewish Welfare Drive Reaches 30% of Quota

Frank H. Sloss, chairman of the Jewish Welfare Fund drive, announced yesterday that 30 per cent of the \$2,750,000 quota has been raised.

He announced a total of \$822,620 in pledges and contributions in a report luncheon at the St. Francis Hotel.

"The formation of Israel, immediately recognized by the President of the United States," he declared, "gives the Jewish Welfare Fund of San Francisco the greatest opportunity in its history.

Ann Liepah, recently returned after directing the Joint Distribution Commission aid center at Machod, on the Czech-Polish border, told of aid given thousands of Jews, victims of anti-Semitism in Poland.
