

## ALL WHITE PAPER LAWS ABOLISHED

PROCLAMATION OF PROVISIONAL STATE COUNCIL

By virtue of the Declaration of Independence published today, the 5th of Iyar, 5708 (14th of May, 1948), according to which the Provisional State Council and the Provisional Government of the State of Israel were established, the Provisional State Council hereby adopts the following law:-

> The Provisional State Council is the Legislative Authority.

The Provisional State Council may grant and does hereby grant authority to the Provisional Government to pass urgent legislation.

The provisions of the law deriving from the White Paper of 1949, hereby repealed.

Paragraphs 13-15 of the Immigration Ordinance, 1941, and regulations 102-107 of the Defence (Emergency) Regulations, 1945, are hereby repealed.

The Land Transfer Regulations, 1945, are hereby repealed retrospectively with effect from the 29th of Iyar, 5699, (18th of May, 1939).


